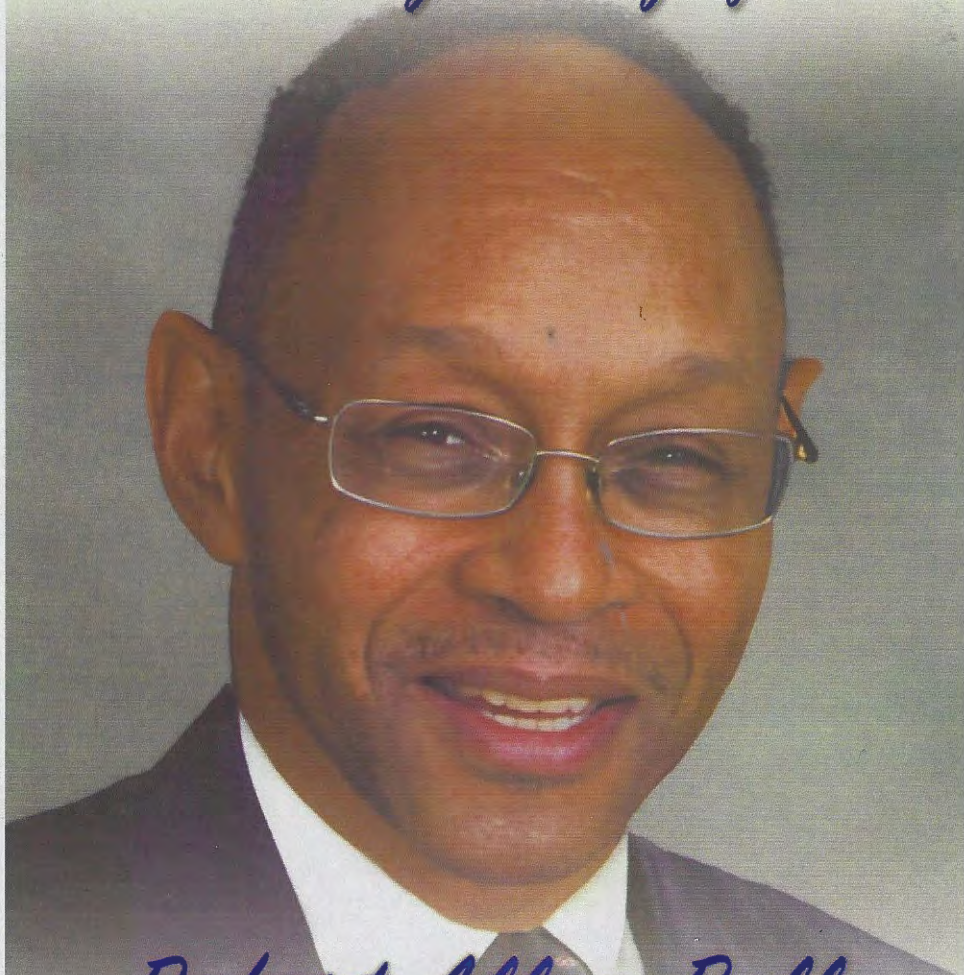

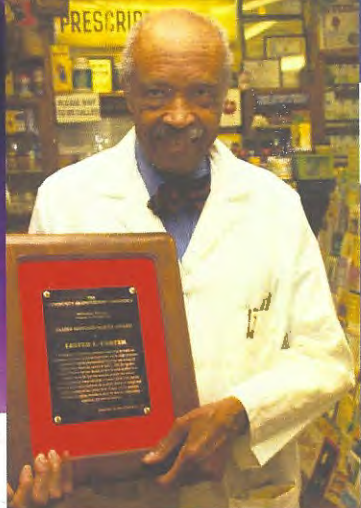

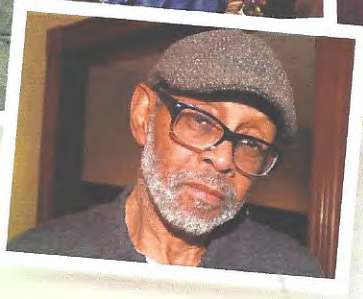
IN LOVING MEMORY OF ROBERT BELL TO MANY KNOWN AS BOB.
